COVID-19 Visitation Policy

Facility visitor policies have been updated to reflect national efforts to limit the spread of COVID-19 in the U.S. This policy may change at any time due to the rapidly evolving situation.

- Visitors will be screened at the entrance by a staff member. Visitors that pass a temperature check and screening questions will be required to sign in.
- Visitors will only be allowed if they are not known to be positive, do not have symptoms of respiratory infection (fever, runny nose, cough, or shortness of breath) and have no known exposure to a positive person.
- Visitors are required to make an appointment ahead of time with the facility to visit.
- Visitation hours will only be held during 10am and 7pm
- The number of visitors at one time in the facility will be limited to 4
- Only 2 visitors per resident can visit at one time
- Visitation time will be limited to 30 minutes
- No visitors will be allowed for residents with a pending or positive COVID-19 test
- All visitors must wear a face. Covering or mask (covering mouth and nose) at the facility for the duration of visit. If a visitor is seen removing their face covering or mask, they will be asked to leave.
- Children who visit must be able to wear a mask or face covering
- If the facility is having an outbreak visitations will be suspended until cleared
- When weather permits visitation will be encouraged to be held outdoors
- During visitation room door will be open and/or staff will randomly enter room in order for staff to ensure Policies are being followed
